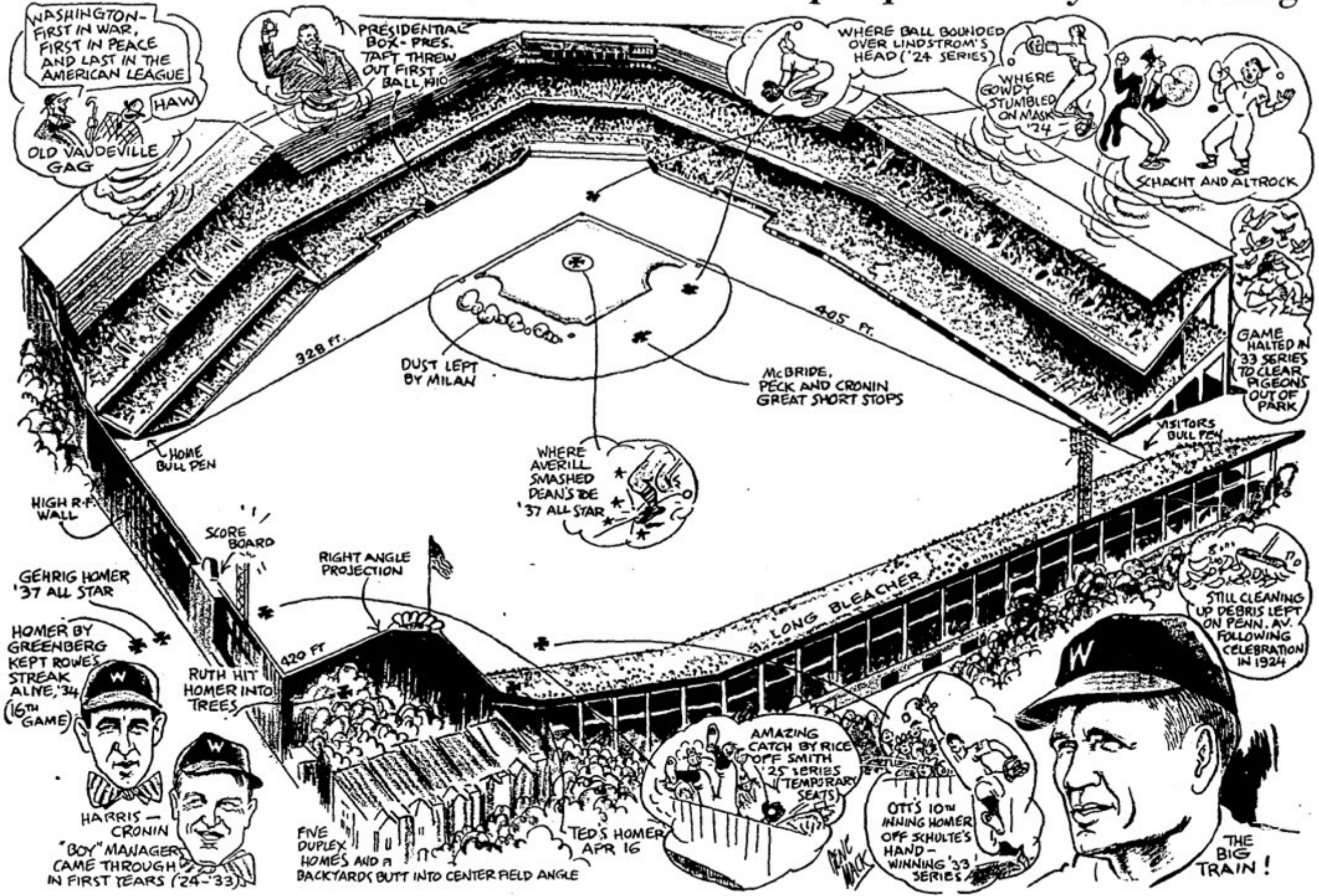


# Griffith Stadium Rebuilt After 1911 Fire ∴ Kept Up-to-Date by Remodeling
