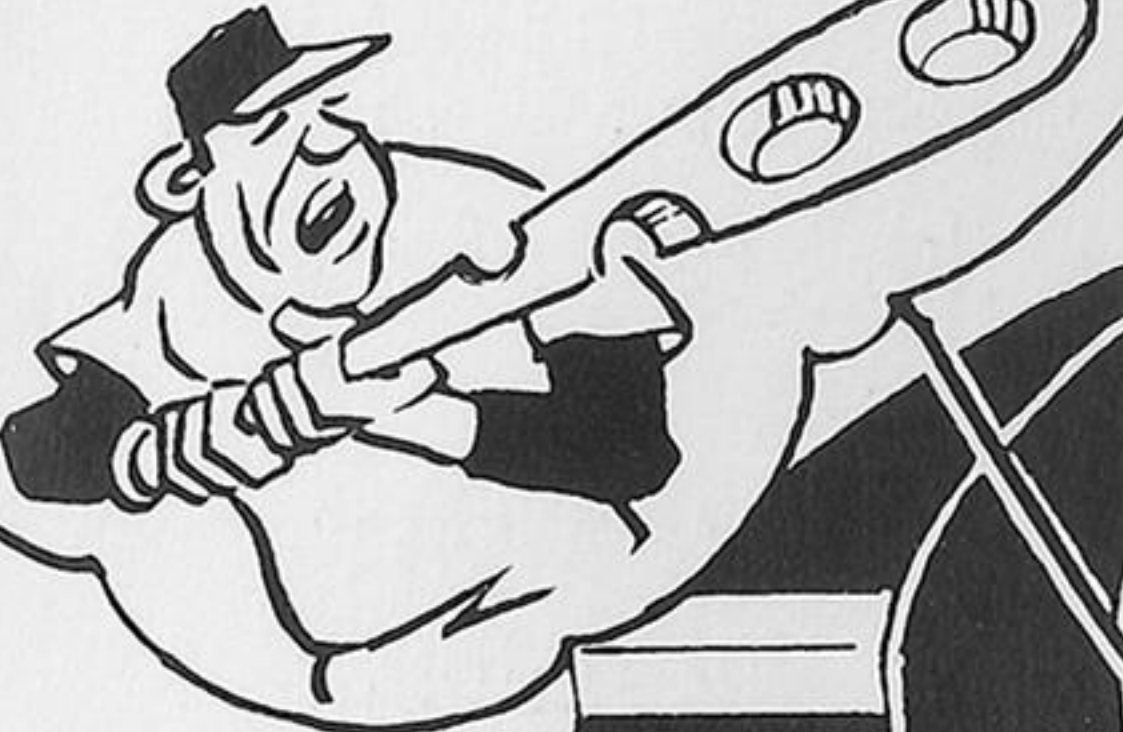

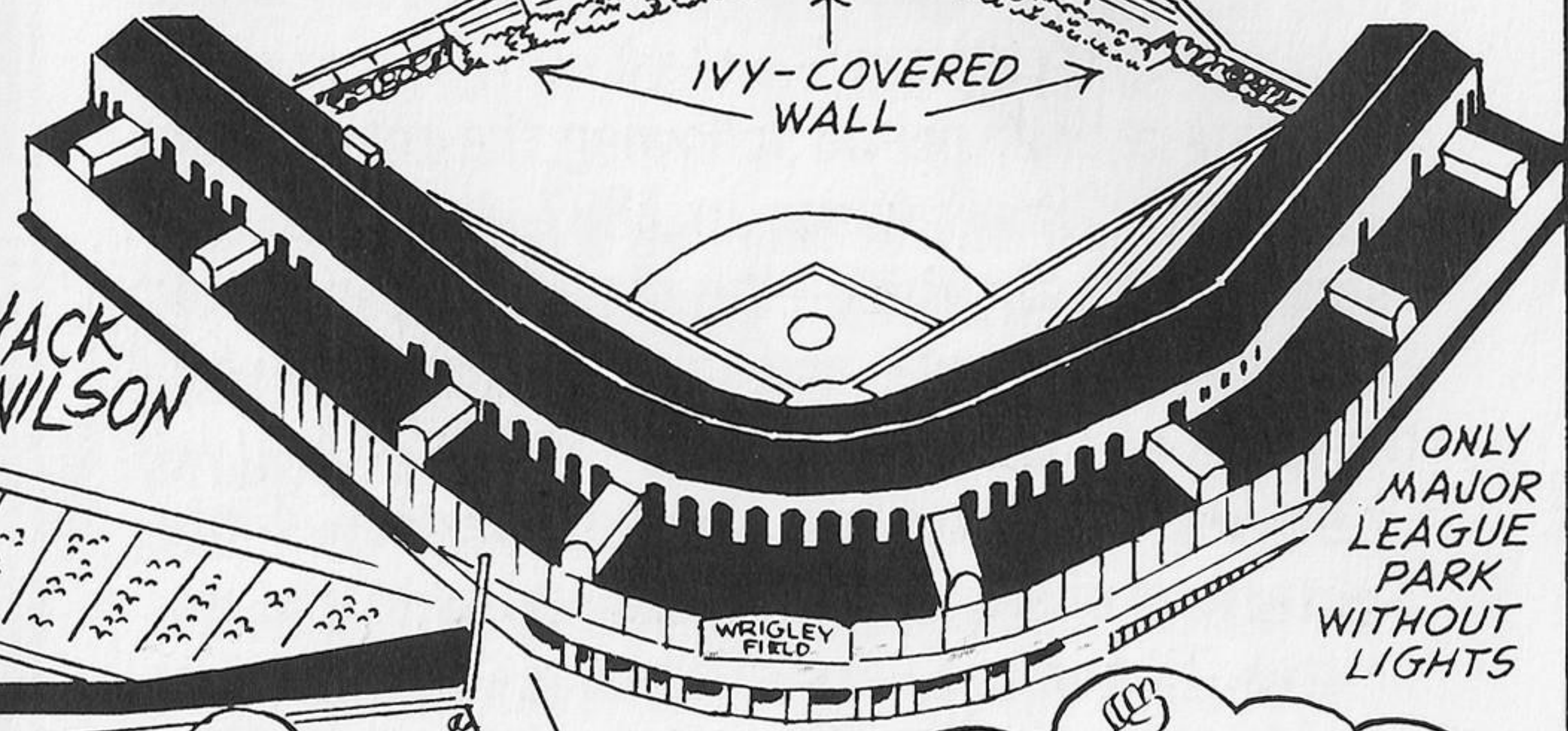


TRADITIONAL FLAG

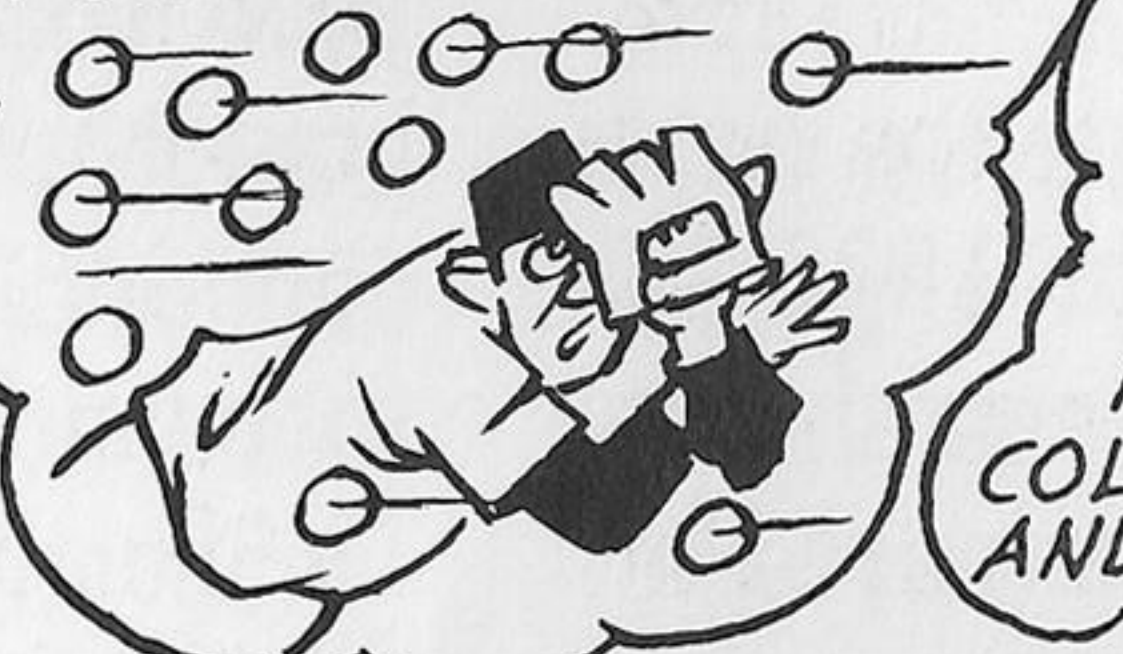
